

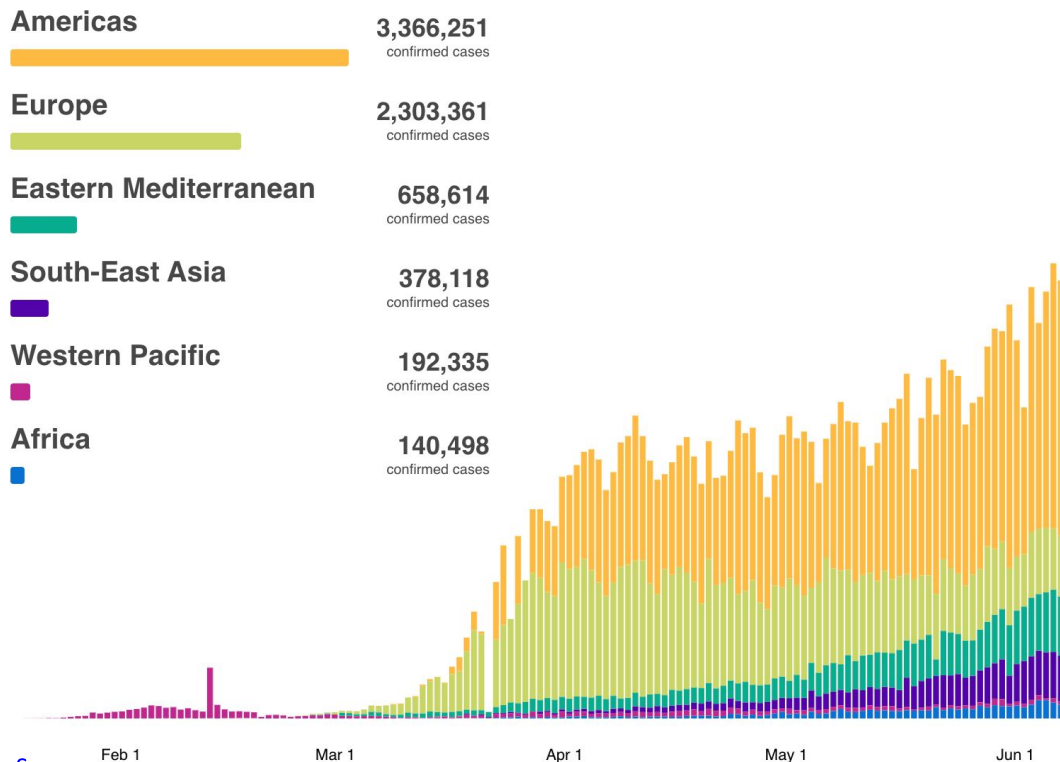

Global cases

COVID-19 has infected over [7 million worldwide, with at least 404,000 fatalities.](#)

Rapid increase in Latin America

COVID-19 is [rapidly surging in Latin America](#) as the crisis pushes the region to its limit. Brazil has the [second-highest number](#). Peru surpassed [200,000 cases](#).

Reopening, despite new cases

Moscow records over [1,000 new cases per day](#) but abruptly ends its lockdown.

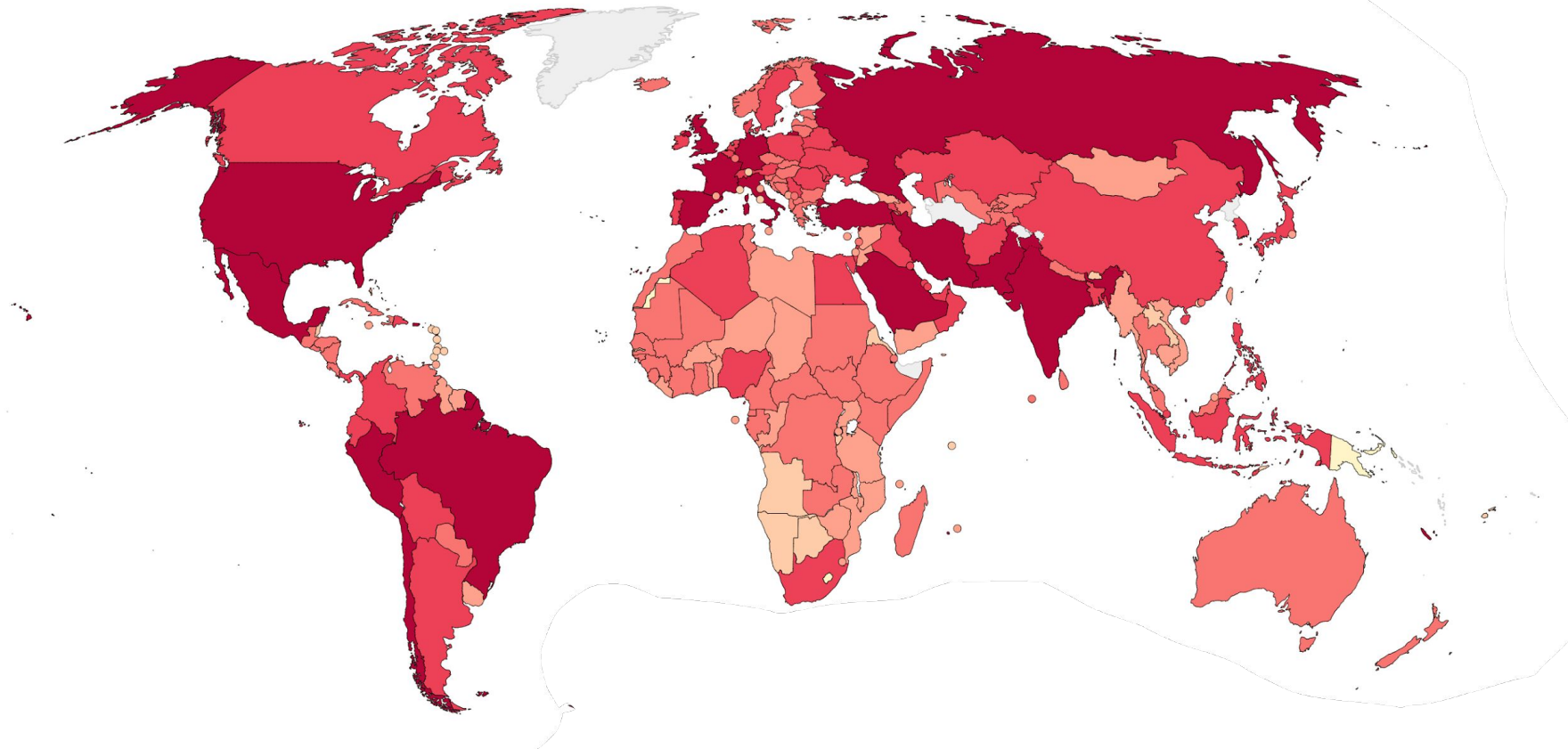
India reported its [biggest one-day jump](#) in new cases as holy places open their doors.

Increase in cases

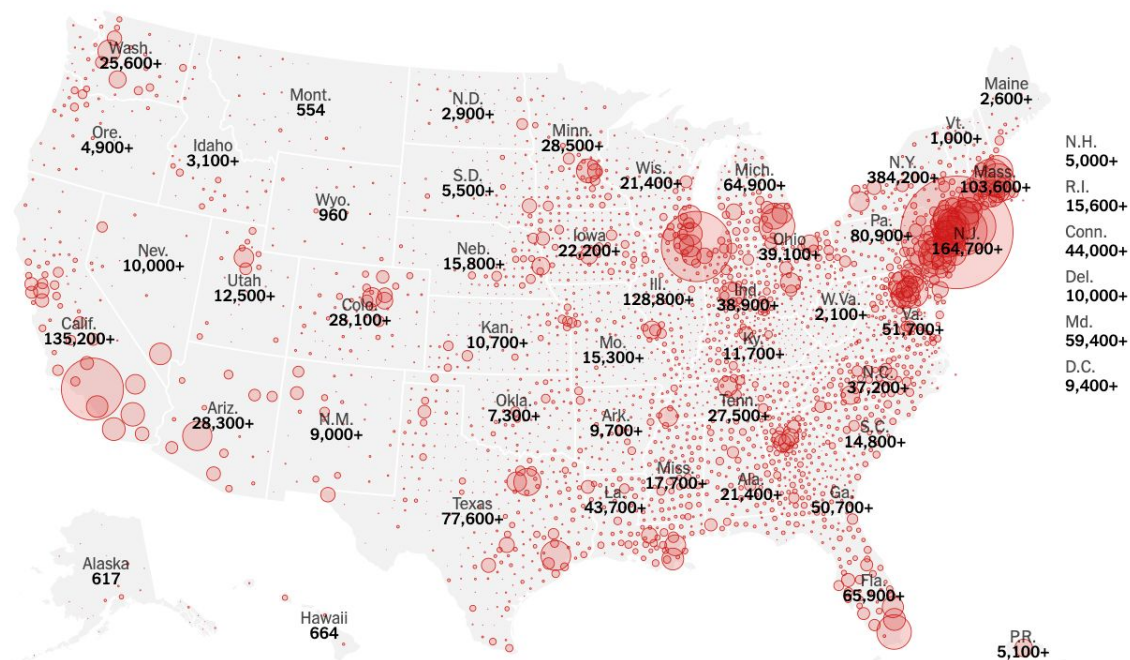
Higher rates of COVID-19 cases are reported [in 22 states](#) as Americans head out to socialize and protest.

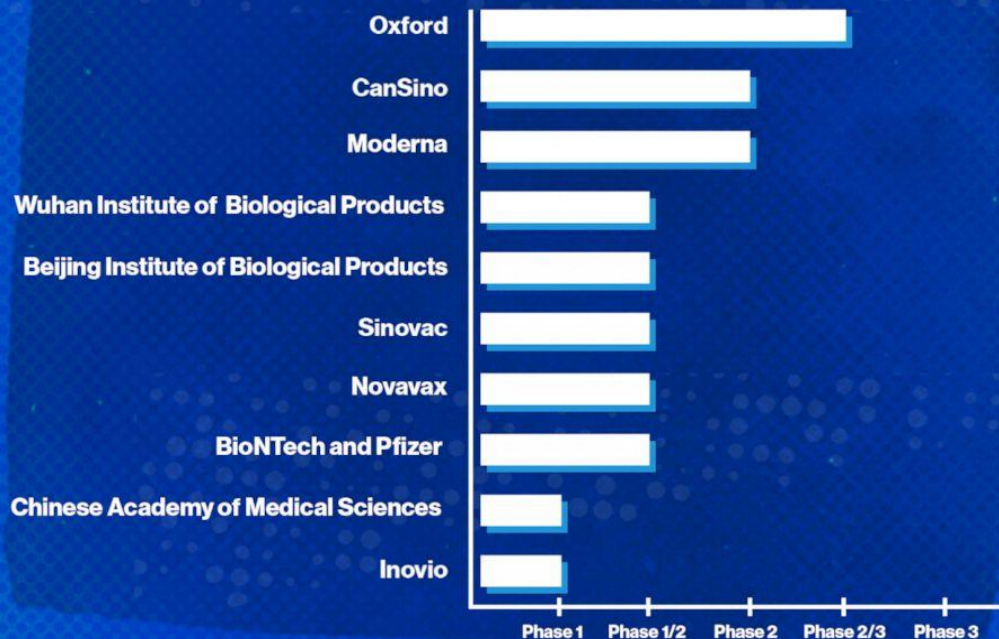

Race to a vaccine

The world's leading drug companies, universities and governments are [racing to develop a vaccine](#) with ten [approved for human trials](#).

U.S. infectious disease expert Dr. Anthony S. Fauci stated that COVID-19 was his worst [“worst nightmare,”](#) but he is [“almost certain”](#) that more than one vaccine will be successful.

The U.S. backs antibody research
